RULING: CHOICE OF LAW PROVISION
INVALID BECAUSE IT VIOLATES A
FUNDAMENTAL ILLINOIS POLICY AND
ILLINOIS HAS A MATERIALLY GREATER
INTEREST THAN CALIFORNIA IN THE
DETERMINATION OF THIS ISSUE.

Choice of law clauses are usually valid, unless they fall under these two circumstances:

(a) the chosen state has no substantial relationship or

(b) application of the law of the chosen state would be contrary to a fundamental policy of a state which has a materially greater interest.

COMMON MISCONCEPTIONS

ONLY STATE LAWS CAN BE DECIDED IN STATE COURT

State courts are the final arbiters of state law, but federal court can still rule on state law.

PERSUASIVE VS. PRECEDENT

Judge can listen to another district, but not necessarily.

APPEALS ARE RE-TRIALS

Trial courts determine issues of material fact. But an appellate court can determine how the law applies.



WRIGHT V. VER 31 JULY 2019

Born in the US, now lives in St. Kitts and Nevis. Says he founded Bitcoin, Allegedly defamatory tweets/ YouTube comments.





Fourth Estate Public Benefit Corporation v. Wall-Street.com

March 4, 2019

Resolved longstanding conflict in the circuit courts, sided with the 10th and 11th circuits. Now have to get your copyright registered to sue.



Rimini Street Inc. v. Oracle

LIMITS COPYRIGHT FEE AWARDS

- (1) clerk and marshal fees,
- (2) transcript fees,
- (3) printing and witness fees and costs,
- (4) exemplification & copying fees,
- (5) docket fees and
- (6) compensation of court-appointed experts and interpreters.

SAVED \$12.8 MILLION

\$35.6 million in copyright infringement \$3.4 million in costs \$28.5 million in attorney's fees \$14.4 million for violations of state computer access laws

"FULL COSTS" DISPUTED

Court rules unanimously.

Also March 4, 2019.



Can states be sued in federal court for copyright law violations?

Case involves alleged copyright violations of footage from the archeological excavation of Blackbeard's Queen Anne's Revenge.



Cybersquatting



According to the World Intellectual Property Organization, cypbersquatting set a new record in 2018, up 12 percent. ADR Forum cases rose 13 percent.

(For Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution cases. US claimants can also file under the ACPA but that's more rare.)

Example:

UBS AG v. Josephine Henry / goldvaultsecurity

Claim Number: FA1907001851160

"UBSoffshorebank.com" violates international policy



Domino's vs. Robles 18-1539

TO DECIDE:

Whether Title III of the ADA requires a website or mobile phone application that offers goods or services to the public to satisfy accessibility requirements with respect to individuals with disabilities.


RISING TIDE OF LITIGATION

In 2018 alone, litigants filed over 2,250 federal lawsuits asserting ADA violations based on web-site inaccessibility, nearly tripling the number in 2017. https://tinyurl.com/y3y7o3rg.






